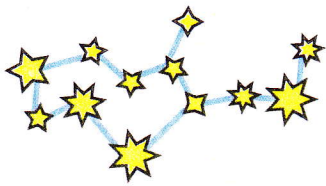


PLAYMATES MARCH KINDERGARTEN NEWSLETTER

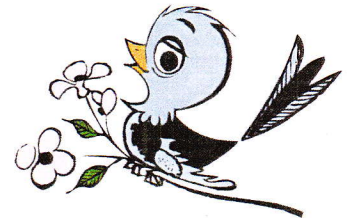
